Course Overview and Objectives	Course overview: This course will offer an overview of nursing in the Canadian healthcare system. The students will have the opportunity to learn about acute care and primary health care by attending seminars and participating in tours at local hospitals and community health centers. The students will gain an understanding of the diversity of First Nations, Inuit and Metis people's health and the challenges of rural and northern nursing. Vulnerable populations will be discussed in the context of health equity, including immigrants and people living in poverty.
